Eligibility

- Graduate of a certified PA or NP program within the last 12 months
- Board certified as a PA, NP, or AGNP (or have exam scheduled)
- Hold or apply for a valid, unencumbered NV license as a PA or NP
- Must not be employed (or employed a max of 9 months) as a PA/NP
